CICBD's engagement with Cayman's small businesses revealed a prevalent presence of lifestyle businesses. Despite their longevity, many of these businesses have struggled to scale effectively over time. Recognizing this gap, the "Business Growth Incubator" programme was conceived. This initiative acknowledges that while numerous established businesses possess substantial potential to bolster economies, they often encounter challenges navigating the growth phase on their own.

The programme has been well received, emerging as CICBD's flagship programme. It identifies and assists existing micro and small businesses with established markets, and equips them with the knowledge and tools necessary to foster business growth. Through a combination of training, coaching, and personalized guidance, the program empowers entrepreneurs to adapt, customize, and implement strategies and methodologies imparted during the sessions.

Following the intensive twelve-week training period, participants receive continued business development support. This includes access to assigned business advisors and mentors for a duration of one (1) year, aimed at propelling their businesses to new heights.




